Frank Martin

Currently: UMASS Amherst

Previously: Kansas State and The University of South Carolina – In 2009-10, Martin led Kansas State to a 29-8 record, an Elite Eight appearance, and he was recognized as the Big 12 Coach of the Year. At South Carolina, Frank Martin broke the record for wins in a single season with 26 in 2016-17 on the way to the best NCAA Tournament run in program history. Martin led the Gamecocks to their first NCAA Tournament win since 1973 and to the program's first-ever Sweet 16, Elite Eight, and Final Four appearance while earning the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year honor. Coach Martin will begin as the Men's Basketball Coach at UMASS this season.



Melissa Graves

Currently: Boston University

Previously: Wake Forest Assistant Coach, Yale University Assistant Coach – Graves achieved immediate success in her first year in 2021-22, guiding BU to a third-place finish in the Patriot League with a 12-6 league record, and going 17-14 overall to reach the Patriot League semifinal round. BU's 12 PL wins tied for the highest amount since the Terriers joined the league ahead of the 2013-14 campaign. BU also notched its first win over an ACC opponent in five seasons when it took down Boston College 69-65.



Paul Biancardi

Currently: ESPN

Previously: Wright State University, Head Men's Basketball Coach – In 2009-10, Coach Biancardi first joined ESPN in 2006 as a college and high school basketball analyst. He became ESPN's national recruiting director in 2008. He is a voting member of the McDonald's All American Committee, the Gatorade State and National Player of the Year, and the Naismith Player of the Year.



John Carroll

Previously: Former Head Coach of Northfield Mount Herman Academy – John Carroll is a legend among active high school coaches. He has coached well over 160 NCAA basketball players including numerous players that have matriculated to the Ivy League. Coach Carrol has coached teams to three New England Championships (2012, 2016, and 2018), winning the National Championship in 2013. He has coached over 35 McDonalds All-American nominees and has attended hundreds of NCAA and NBA practices and professional development opportunities.
